1. ITINERARY

Competitors are advised the Itinerary as supplied in Road Books at administrative checks and in Bulletin 1 is the current version.

2. 2018 FIA WRC SPORTING REGULATIONS

All competitors are advised, that an up-to-date version (03.04.2018) of the 2018 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations is published on the FIA website (<https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/119>).

3. SAS TRACKER UNIT - STOPPING ON A SPECIAL STAGE / SHAKEDOWN

All competitors are strongly reminded to comply with the 2018 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, **Articles 40.3 and 40.4**. In particular, in all cases when a car stops temporarily or definitively on a special stage or on the Shakedown and immediate medical intervention is **not** required, **the OK must be pressed** immediately but at the latest **within one minute** on the Emergency Console (SAS Tracker Unit). All other procedures as laid down in the Regulations must also be respected. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

4. RED FLAG PROCEDURE

All competitors are strongly reminded to comply with the 2018 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, **Article 40.5**, and in particular to immediately **acknowledge** receipt if the message "**RED FLAG**" is displayed on the Emergency Console (SAS Tracker), to immediately **reduce speed** and to maintain that reduced speed **until the STOP Control**.

5. TYRE BARCODES

All competitors are strongly reminded to respect all the provisions in relation to barcode numbers and their visibility, and in particular **2018 WRC FIA Sporting Regulations, Article 60.1.4**.

6. REMINDER OF APPENDIX L ISG - DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Competitors are strongly reminded that the Drivers' safety equipment (including helmet, gloves, balaclava and safety belts) **must be worn correctly until the STOP control**. The balaclava must be worn under the racing suit.

7. TRAFFIC RULES

All competitors are strongly reminded of the traffic regulations in force throughout the entire event, in particular concerning respect of speed limits and the prohibition of zig-zag driving.

All competitors are also strongly reminded that according to traffic laws in Turkey it is illegal to use hand held mobile devices while driving. This will be monitored and all infringements will be reported to the Stewards.

8. RECONNAISSANCE Art. 25.4.2 of the 2018 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations

Crews and team members are authorised to use the part of SS14/17 (Marmaris) between Box 9 & 10, Road Book Section 6 p73, for general travel purposes.

9. RED BULL ARCHES

Will be erected on SS's as follows. The arches measure 8met inside width and 3.25met inside height.

- Shakedown 4.61km (on the jump)
- SSS1 on the jump (metal truss supported)
- SS 2 / 5 8.05km Designated Spectator Location (before watercourse Box 6)
- SS 3 / 6 7.79km Designated Spectator Location (after exit of Box 13)
- SS 8 / 11 33.91km
- SS 9 / 12 5.70km
- SS 10 / 13 12.81km Designated Spectator Location
- SS14/17 0.70km Designated Spectator Location (before turn in Box 9)
