1. FACE COVERING

This is to remind you that, when a car stops at any point of the route, including on a special stage, for whatever reason and any of the drivers exits the car with the helmet off, it is in all cases mandatory to wear a face covering, especially when social distancing cannot be respected.

Using of the face mask (PPE) at the Service Park as regulated is being monitored and all infringements will be informed to the COVID-19 Delegate who will report these incidents to the Stewards.

2. SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS – APPENDIX 5 AND FIA INTERNATIONAL SPORTING CODE – APPENDIX L

Reminder of FIA WRC Sporting Regulation, Art 53.1. Competitors are reminded of their requirements regarding the correct wearing of protective clothing on a special stage up to and including the Stop line. All competitors are strongly reminded that the drivers' safety equipment (including balaclava and safety belts) must be worn correctly until the STOP control.

3. EMERGENCY BUTTON

All competitors are reminded to comply with FIA WRC Sporting Regulations Art. 53.3 and 53.4 and in particular to immediately activate the OK/SOS display (at the latest within one minute after stopping) and to comply with all other procedures as laid down in the Regulations in all cases when a car stops temporarily or definitively on a special stage / the Shakedown.

4. RED FLAG PROCEDURE

All competitors are reminded to comply with FIA WRC Sporting Regulations Art. 53.5 and in particular to immediately acknowledge receipt if the message "RED FLAG" is displayed on the screen of the FIA Emergency Console and to immediately reduce speed and to maintain that speed until the STOP control.

5. TYRE BARCODES

All competitors are reminded to respect all the provisions in relation to barcode numbers and their visibility, and in particular FIA WRC Sporting Regulations Art. 13.1.4.

6. MOBILE TELEPHONES

All competitors are reminded that, according to traffic laws, it is illegal to use handheld mobile devices while driving. All infringements will be reported to the Stewards.

7. RECOVERY OF RALLY CARS

The organisers will recover broken cars from a Special Stage and deliver the car to the nearest Recovery Pick Up point. The location of these points is given in the Safety Plan page 30.

These points are also shown in the Road Book Special Stages maps as numbered symbols



If the competitor wishes to have the car returned to the Service Park, this can be arranged at a cost.

8 . Red Bull Arches

Will be erected on SS's as follows. The arches measure 8met inside width and 3.25met inside height.

- SS 4 / 7 Datça 6.50km
- SS 5/8 Kızlan 0.90km
- SS 10/12 Marmaris 0.06km – Bulletin No.2 – Attachment No.2 Box 2

9 . Avis Arches

Will be erected on SS's as follows. The arches measure 8met inside width and 3.25met inside height.

- SS 1 İçmeler 10.15km - Box 13
- SS 5/8 Kızlan 0.33km - Box 3
- SS 10/12 Marmaris 4.05km – Box 12
